

Second Draft of Extended Essay Due Tuesday, September 6, 2011

You are expected to do substantial work to revise and improve your extended essay during the summer. When working on your second draft, pay close attention to the Extended Essay Booklet, the feedback you have received from your advisor, and the rubric detailing your score on your first draft. Your essay should include all of the necessary parts: cover page; abstract; table of contents; intro; body; conclusion; end notes; works cited page.

A 4000 word REVISED AND IMPROVED draft of your extended essay is due on the first day of school – Tuesday, September 6, 2011. This revised and improved draft must be completed before you begin your senior year of school. Your revised and improved draft will be collected on the first day of school during your English classes. If you do not turn in an essay & all required materials, you will be taken out of class, and your parents will be called.

You must turn in **ONE COPY** of your revised and improved essay and a CD on which your essay is saved. Label your disk with your name and *Extended Essay 2nd Draft*.

IN ADDITION TO PULLING YOU OUT OF CLASS AND HAVING YOUR PARENTS CALLED, YOUR EXTENDED ESSAY AND TOK GRADES WILL BE SUBSTANTIALLY LOWERED IF YOU DO NOT TURN IN ALL OF THE REQUIRED MATERIALS IN THE CORRECT FORMAT ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

During first semester 2011 you will have to pass a citation check. During the citation check, I will check all of your sources and make sure that you have not plagiarized your essay. The citation check is a graded assignment, and you will not pass extended essay or TOK if you fail your citation check. During the citation check, you must have all of your sources and/or photocopies of the relevant pages of your sources. If you are using photocopies make sure you photocopy the relevant pages as well as the title page and copyright information.

Good luck this summer. Remember, the more work you do over the summer, the less work you will have to do in the fall when you will be focusing on your college applications, SATs, and your challenging senior classes.
